



Guidelines for In-Person Worship at All Saints' Church (updated December 2021)

I. Guidance on Who Should Attend

The best way for our congregation to keep each other healthy is to **NOT** attend in-person worship if:

• You have had a new onset of symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 2 weeks. Common symptoms include:

- Loss of taste or smell
- Cough
- Chills
- Trouble Breathing
- Sore Throat
- Exhaustion
- Headaches
- Diarrhea

- Symptoms or a positive COVID-19 test in the last 14 days
- You were exposed to someone with the above

We encourage members who plan to attend services in person regularly also to be tested regularly for COVID-19. To find a testing site, visit <https://www.nychealthandhospitals.org/covid-19-testing-sites/>.

II. Demarcating Physical Distance

Physical distancing is not currently required for masked attendees seated in the congregation. We continue to emphasize physical distancing (approximately six feet of distance between anyone not in your household) when receiving Communion and at all times when food and drink are being consumed. Markers on the floor will help to indicate six feet.

III. Masks

Proper and complete mask use will be a requirement to attend worship and will be monitored and enforced by an usher. Masks must be worn over the mouth and nose at all times with no exceptions. High-quality KN95 masks are available at the entrance of the church, as well as blue surgical masks. Masks must be worn during limited fellowship events at the back of the church.

IV. Singing

Congregational singing with masks has resumed as of June 6, 2021.

V. Hand Sanitizer

There are hand sanitizer dispensers at the church entrance.

VI. Cleaning

The church receives intermittent professional cleaning.

VII. Ventilation

The doors and windows of the church will be kept ajar during services to aid airflow.

VIII. Ushers

You will be greeted by Ushers, who will facilitate registration, direct the flow of worshippers to their seats, and ensure that attendees adhere to all guidelines. Please be courteous and follow the Ushers' instructions.
